Candle Bible for Toddlers - With only a line or two of

text on each page accompanied by large bright pictures, this is a great way of introducing Bible characters and stories to young children.



The Jesus Storybook Bible – A great Bible for children and parents to read together, written with lovely language, and consistently bringing the stories round to pointing to Jesus.



Children of God Storybook Bible – Written by Archbishop Desmond Tutu, this Bible has stunning pictures – each story on a double page spread is illustrated by a different artist. The stories are short, and finish with a one line prayer for children to say.

The Barnabas Family Bible

A great way of working through the Bible in 110 stories, with questions, activities and prayer ideas for everyone.





The Children's Bible in 365

Stories – This is the Bible we use on Sunday mornings to read stories from. It is also great to use to read one story a day and read the whole Bible in a year together!

The Action Bible Devotional – A years worth of weekly devotions to work through the Bible from start to finish, including activities and questions to think about (aimed more at 7-11 years).
