Dear Friends

In a few weeks' time we will be celebrating Pentecost when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the first believers. It is always a great time to celebrate and give thanks to God for his presence with us and his provision of himself for us. On Pentecost Sunday we will be having some **baptisms** at both our morning and our evening services. It is not too late to come forward to be baptised so if that is something you would like to do then do get in touch with myself or another member of the clergy.

In the ten days leading up to Pentecost we will be taking part in the **'Thy Kingdom Come' prayer initiative.** This has been going for a number of years now and it will be great to reengage with it again this year. The pray is centred on evangelism and we will be praying for those we long to see become Christians as well as our role as witnesses to the good news. We will have a few opportunities to gather to pray; firstly our **Encounter prayer meeting on Thursday 26**th and then we will be using the evening service on the 29th as a time of praise and pray. In the past we have invited other churches to join us at this service of prayer but this year it will just be an SMB event. I hope that next year when we are fully past the events of the last few years we might be able to host that gathering of churches again.

Alongside all of this we will be running a **24/7 prayer room**. This will be set up in our committee room and it would be great if we could fill as many of the slots as possible. Even if you can't come into the prayer room itself you might put yourself down in a slot to offer prayer from your home.
