Ministry Letter

Dear Friends

As we will all know and will all be experiencing the cost of living is rising and causing a squeeze on people's finances. As always, this squeeze will be tighter on some more than others, pushing some into a place of real crisis. I want to take this opportunity to suggest a couple of ways you might think about responding to this crisis and helping others if you are in a position to do so. Firstly we have in our church accounts a 'Family Fund'. This fund can be used at the discretion of the Vicar and Wardens to help those within the church family who might find themselves in a crisis. If we hear of a need then even if the family fund doesn't currently have any funds in it, we do still look to help. However, having funds ready for this purpose in the family fund is really useful as it is a good mechanism to provide help. If you would like to give into this fund then do send through your gift though the office and make it clear that it is for the family fund. Equally if you know of anyone within the church family who needs help then do speak to myself or the wardens and we will look to respond as quickly as possible. Secondly you might also think about supporting the work of CAP (Christians against Poverty) more directly. We fund the CAP debt centre here at SMB through our general fund, however some people choose alongside their regular giving to give directly to the CAP ministry either through one-off gifts or a regular donation. Any money given this way would go directly to support the debt centre and free up money from the general fund to use elsewhere. Again, if this is something you would like to do then please make clear that any gift or standing order is for this purpose. CAP is an amazing ministry and I think demand for it will be increasing as more people find themselves in that place of crisis due to the cost of living.

Finally on a completely different matter, we are redesigning our Family News to make it more accessible and more useful as a digital newsletter. At the moment as you can see it is still formatted as a paper leaflet however as a result of lockdown and a desire to use less paper we are no longer handing it out before the service and instead sending it as you will have received it this morning by email. Therefore we are reformatting it to work better as an email. All the same information will still be there but it will be better integrated with our website for more information and sign ups. So do look out for the new Family News email as we make the change in the next few weeks.
